Background

Polish NGDO Platform Zagranica Group has initiated a multi-stakeholder process that brings together different actors active in the field of Development/Global Education in Poland. The main output of the group should result in a national agreement on DE/GE.

There is now a need for securing cooperation with the newly identified actors and their active participation in the process. It will only be possible if representatives of each institution (especially the ones who lack experience) will acquire basic knowledge on DE/GE.

Expected outcomes of the seminar

The participants will:

- acquire knowledge on DE/GE and understand the place of DE/GE in the curriculum

- promote DE/GE among teachers and contribute to mainstreaming DE/GE in formal education
